Junior Outdoor Education Instructor – Wild Paws Camps

Western Educational Adventures (WEA) runs outdoor adventure camps for kids on Vancouver Island, primarily in the Greater Victoria area. Our goal is to teach children valuable life skills and give them an appreciation of nature through exciting outdoor adventures. WEA is looking for **Junior** Outdoor Education Instructors/Camp Counsellors to help facilitate our new Wild Paws Day camp programs in 2022. Staff may get the opportunity to work on our other camps from time to time. Position periods include on-call and summer camp. We ask you to take a moment to thoroughly review this job description and our website before applying.

Remuneration

\$137.25 - \$142.5/day depending on certification and experience.

WEA is looking for outdoor staff to work one or more of the following programs:

- Summer Camps – June 12th to September 3rd, 2022

Hours

Staff start at 08:00 and finish at 17:00, Monday to Friday at one of the following locations:

1. Elk/Beaver Lake Park
2. Thetis Lake Park
3. Sooke Area

Considerations:

- The exact location will vary each week depending on which program staff are assigned to.
- Breaks are available throughout the day.
- Staff may be asked to work one of our other camps from time to time. They would be required to work as per the hours of the other applicable positions.



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Expectations

WEA staff are expected to:

- Be skilled and passionate about working with children, being outside and teaching others.
- Display WEA's values and beliefs while operating within scope of training and WEA's standards and policies.
- Demonstrate solid risk management ability and be able to problem solve.
- Maintain a high standard of professionalism, including time management and communication.
- Demonstrate respect and value for the natural environment through ideologies like nature identification, no-trace camping, etc.

Responsibilities

This contract requires you to be able to perform various functions and duties, some of which are listed below:

- Facilitate various outdoor activities such as forest games, kayaking, canoeing, swimming, archery, hiking, wilderness navigation, orienteering, geocaching, fishing, etc.
- Facilitate unstructured exploration time in wilderness and city park settings
- Provide first aid as necessary
- Supervise participants on full day programs in public park settings
- Clean and prep facilities, program supplies, vehicles, etc.
- Attend required training sessions
- Provide constructive feedback for supervisors, other staff, and programs
- Complete other tasks as directed by a supervisor or manager
- Occasionally assist on WEA's other camp programs

Minimum qualifications:

- Standard First Aid & CPR-C
- At least 2 months experience working with children
- Clear criminal record check with vulnerable sector screening

Desired qualifications:

- 40 hr Wilderness First Aid
- Bronze Cross or National Lifeguard certification
- Food Safe Level 1
